MD opened the meeting and welcomed everyone to the AGM



Chair/Secretary Annual Report Agenda item:

MD referenced the annual report document circulated to membership

MD highlighted the following:

- Club sessions have expanded with more opportunities for discipline specific sessions in Cyclocross and MTB. The club has also added an additional fundamental sessions on a Tuesday night. This year has also seen activities expanded to more locations in Falkirk, including sessions running on a Saturday in 2 locations
- The club successfully organised a range of cycling events catering for all levels of competition. This included hosting 2 national series events as well as the National Cyclo-Cross Trophy, including the Race to the stars event which was a highlight of the year
- The club continued to support the local community, with school holiday club sessions providing coaching and free lunches as well as through the Scottish Cycling Rock up and Ride Programme.
- Awarded Scottish Cycling "Club of the Year" and "Event of the Year" as well as Sports Scotland "Sports Club of the Year.
- Plans for the future -
 - The opening of the new cycle circuit in Linlithgow will allow the club to extend its discipline specific opportunities providing road riding opportunities to members
 - The club is looking to increase adult commitment, encouraging more volunteering opportunities., to help support and develop our young coaches.
 - The club has secured funding to encourage new riders into the sport, including a specific focus to encourage more girls to join the club.

Agenda item:	Treasurer Reporting of Accounts	Presenter:	Paul Burns	

PB gave a rundown of the Trustees' Annual Report and Accounts:

- Accounts are prepared in line with charities regulator guidelines (OSCR) and signed off by independent reviewer of accounts, a full audit is not required due to the size of the organization
- Significant increase in receipts mainly within grant income including £14,100 from Falkirk Council Holiday Sessions and £7730 from Scottish Cycling Rock up and Ride and £9,840 from the National Lottery Awards for All Scotland Fund
- Payments also increased significantly in 2022, by £57,540, reflecting increased activities relating to holiday sessions, purchase of club bicycles and increased events.

Mark Drackford Presenter:

- The closing cash balance figure was noted, a decrease of 16k on the previous year's closing cash balance, although it was highlighted this was not a concern due to specific circumstances noted.
- Unrestricted monies of £7251 resulted, a decrease of £10,377 on the previous year. £6874 of this decrease related to liabilities from 2021
- The trustees noted the decrease in unrestricted reserves, but remain content with the level of unrestricted reserves held, the agreed level of reserves the club should hold is £2000.
